Registration Statistics: Year to date report for NJ Swimming Coaches: There are 535 registered coaches. Out of this number 138 are flagged with alerts. The alerts on coaches are for various reasons.

QR Codes on Certifications: All certificates MUST have a QR code in the lower right hand corner. At the end of 2013 the American Red Cross added the Quick Response (QR) Codes. If they are scanned, the course participant's information will pop up. The QR codes were added as a security measure. When the code is scanned, it brings up information about that individual and the course they completed. It has the name of the person that took the course, the type of course they took, the date they completed the course, and the name of the instructor. The information that comes up when you scan the code should match what is on the printed certification. If the information does not match, then it is a fake certification.

Meet Credentials: As the winter season begins please check your credentials to make sure they are up to date. You will need to make sure you have either your credentials with you or Deck Pass on your phone. All green means you are fine, red means that item has expired, and yellow is a caution that you are expiring shortly.

Athlete Protection Training: A new APT renewal course was released September 1, 2015. It is a 45-minute scenario based training course that is required of all renewing non-athlete members. The renewal is good for two years.
